<p>DAY 1</p>	<p>Welcome, introduction</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Get to know each other • Get to know the school • Take care of the school animals • Explanation of the assignment • Start lessons with basic knowledge of the dog • Different breeds and their behavior • Health and health checkpoints <p>Activity: Bowling and eating together</p>
<p>DAY 2</p>	<p>Theory day</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take care of the school animals • Theory in the morning about the different dog businesses in the Netherlands. Housing and hygiene • Guest lecture chosen from the list of possible excursions/masterclasses/workshops <p>For example the LID. Masterclass about the routine checks on pensions and shelters</p>
<p>DAY 3</p>	<p>Excursion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Excursion to an animal shelter, boarding house and dog kennel. • For example Stichting zwerfdier Alkmaar and Dierentehuis Alkmaar, now in Purmerend, goes back to Alkmaar • For example: Combining with an bicycle tour round Alkmaar
