The theme for your visit to the Netherlands is Dog Business. There will be both a practical and theoretical approach to this topic, with classroom lessons as well as study visits and mornings where you take care of our school animals.

For the two weeks you'll be staying at 'the King's Inn' hostel in the historical centre of Alkmaar which is 15 minutes walking from our school. There are rooms with two beds. Bedsheets and towels are included. The breakfast is at the Kings Inn, you make lunch at the Kings Inn and take it with you. ## 4. Presentations/lessons

The students from Vonk prepare their own presentations about the subject that they will get from the teacher. With the presentation they make a small teacher manual. For every dia they fill in the text that they want to say and time that it will take to talk about. For the students who make the presentations we decide the purpose, subjects and performance. They have to work with that given material.

## 5. Theoretical assignments

The students from Vonk develop assignments associated with the presentation they make. Below you can find examples of assignments.

## Assignment one: Dog breeds and health

During the theoretical lesson and in the Virtual Assignment you have learnt about the different dogbreeds we have. You also learnt that each country has different popular breeds. From origin, every breed has their own purpose. In the first part of this assignment you will look into the different dog breed groups, their character description and external characteristics and you name five dogbreeds that fit in that group.

In the second part you will look into the health of the dogs and how you check the health during your work in the shelter of pension. If you start in the morning with the first round of feeding and taking care of the dogs, you look at the dogs. Make a list of health checkpoints which you can use during the feeding round. You see the dog from a distance so you can't look in to his ears of mouth. This list is about the first impression you get from the dog. In the list you describe how a healthy dog looks like or responds and two deviations that may occur.

## Assignment two: Hygiene protocol

After the feeding it is time that the dogs get a clean kennel. In the theoretical lesson you learnt about cleaning and disinfecting the kennel. For this assignment you make a hygiene protocol what your employees can use in your company.

Step one: Make a drawing of your kennel according to existing directives and describe it. What kind of material you choose on the floor and on the walls. Argue why you choose these kind of materials for your kennel.

Step two: For the protocol, make two step-by-step plans: part cleaning and part disinfecting. In your steps, don't forget to indicate how it can be carried out as efficiently as possible.

Step three: Indicate per step how much time you think you will need to carry it out.
Step four: Make a list of the materials (including disinfectant) needed during the work
Step five: Place the meaning of the safety icons on the cleaning and disinfectants in your protocol.

Step six: Indicate which safety measures are prescribed via the safety icons
Step seven: Check that all steps are clearly and clearly described

## Guest lecture LID

In this guest lecture you learn about what kind of routine checks the LID does. Make notes during the lesson and make sure you use this information in the group assignment.
Examples of topics that come back in the group assignment are:

- What kind of checks do they carry out?
- How often does the LID visits?
- What protocols should you have in your company


## Assignment five: Law and regulations

As you learn in the lessons you have to do a couple of things before you can start your company. And that if you have a company you can earn quality marks for animal welfare form example. You must also adhere to a number of rules regarding the occupational health and safety of your employees.
This assignment consists of three parts.
First part
In this assignment you describe the steps you have to follow to start a company in your own country.
So you have a description for the Netherlands, for Finland, for Norway and for Sweden.

## Second part

After you have done that you look into the quality marks your country can give your company. Choose for each country one quality mark and describe which requirements your company must meet in order to earn the quality mark.

## Third part

In the last part you look into the rules regarding the occupational health and safety of your employees.
The working conditions act is an extensive law. You zoom in to the specific category of physical strain. Working in the animal care is a physically demanding job. It's the employers job to make this work as pleasant as possible. For each country you look into this part of the working conditions and answer the following questions:

- What is the maximum weight that you can lift at work?
- How can you make sure that your employees do not have to exceed this weight?
- In your job as an employee in the shelter of pension you have a lot of standing work and cleaning the kennel. During working you have to look out for yourself in standing, sitting, lifting etc. Make a comic strip for every movement that you can use your body in the right ergonomic and wrong way.


## 6. Assignments during excursions

Students from Vonk organise the excursions. Organise the excursions includes make an assignment.
With what kind of goal you go to your excursion, after what lesson you plan the excursion, what kind of things do you want that the students learn from the excursion?

## Examples of assignments below

## Assignment three: Excursion Shelter

During the first theoretical lesson we talk about the different breeds and the breedinggroups and about the health checks.
During the excursion you will see also different breeds and learn about the routines they have during work. In this assignment you check your knowledge of the different breeding and looking in to the different daily tasks to prepare yourself for the next theoretical lessons.

## First step:

Make pictures of the different dogbreeds you see. Maybe you see new ones that you don't know yet.
After the excursion you make a list with the picture and the name of the breed.

## Second step:

When you walk trough the kennels, check 4 dogs on their health from a distance. Make pictures or video of abnormalities in the health that you see. After the excursion make a list with your findings

Third step:
In the next theoretical lessons we will talk about hygiene protocols.
Write down the daily tasks and ask yourself which routines and rules would you like to implement in your own company?

## Assignment four: Internship

In this two weeks you will join one student on their internship.
At the end of the day, write down all the tasks that you did. You use this information to write the daily tasks for the group assignment.

## Assignment: Start a dog business on paper

This assignment is a part of the International Animal Care unit "Dog business" Level: EQF4

## Learning outcomes:

- Knowledge about different breeds and breedinggroups of dogs
- Knowledge about health and health checks with dogs
- Knowledge about laws and regulations in housing dogs
- Knowledge about common routines for keeping dogs
- Knowledge about different food and diets for dogs
- Competence to follow current hygiene routines


## What to do:

Complete a handbook about starting your own dog business. The handbook should give a good picture of how your business look like and the routines you have. All the assignments that you do trough the two weeks helps you to fill in your handbook.

## Chapters:

1. Make an introduction of your business by answering the following questions:

- What kind of business do you start?
- What is the name of your business
- For how many dogs do you have room.
- How do you determine which breeds goes in which groups?
- What kind of training do you do with the dogs

2. What does your business looks like?

- Make a map of your business
- Make a small description of all the area's
- In this description you mention
- The dimensions of the kennels
- How to set up your kennels
- What kind of equipment you have for the daily tasks

3. Dayplanning for all the area's

- How many workers work on the different area's
- What is the dayplanning of all the area's
- Implement at least one hygiene protocol for one area
- Implement the health checks on the dogs
- What kind of skills should your employees have?

4. Feeding the dogs

- How many times do you feed the dogs. Why?
- What are you going to feed the dogs. Why?
- What differences do you have in your company?


## Finding facts

Use the information you get from the theoretical lessons, excursions and internshipdays. For more information use reliable sourses for information (who provides the information? Is it a first-hand source? How old is the information? Is it relevant for your context? Are there more sources that gives the same information?)
